It is clear from the events this year that when individuals are elected to the Legislative and Executive branches of our State and Federal governments who repeatedly vote AGAINST the clear will of the people —— we do not have a representative government.

The only way to have an influence on legislation is to elect responsible and ethical legislators! The greatest effort anyone can make towards better legislation is to work to elect responsible Republicans to office. Please find a candidate who meets your criteria and contribute through work and/or money.

If you don't know a candidate, check SVARW's endorsed list or call Candidate Development Chairman Gail DeSmet. If you are at a loss about where to contribute, see SVARW's Contribution Table for forms and candidates (you could also win a \$100 gift certificate in the bargain!). If you'd like to let your friends know who to vote for, please see SVARW's ballot recommendation project. Don't know how to get to these projects – ask any Board Member.

Finally, send a letter to a democrat who voted for health care and tell them that on election day, you will remember that they voted against the "will of the people" on health care, etc.

Freedom of Speech Issue -ACR 82

Last Wednesday the State Senate Education Committee voted 6-1 in favor of ACR 82 (Hall-LA) the joint resolution to create "discrimination-free zones" on all public school campuses. The resolution, instead, will have unintended consequences like promoting the multisexual agenda while limiting student's freedom of speech especially in regards to their personal religious belief. A student that simply states homosexuality is against their personal faith will be considered intolerant and in violation of this resolution, if schools follow through with this resolution. Thank you to Senator Bob Huff (R-Diamond Bar) who voted against the bill, protecting all California students, not just a select few.

ACR 82 will now move to the Senate Floor. Please contact your Senator and urge them to oppose this resolution.

This year the Day of Silence in schools is going to be April 16. It is a day when students and teachers maintain silence all day to support gay rights. Regardless of a person's views, it is not acceptable for teachers not to be available to talk with students for a day. Several school districts will vote by mail in ballots on measures to increase parcel taxes (property taxes) to benefit schools. SVARW recommendations on the 5 ballot measures are:

Measure A Palo Alto Unified School District—Tax Increase No Measure B Fremont Union School District—Tax Increas No

Measure C Lakeside School District —Tax Increase No

Measure G Loma Prieta Joint Union Elementary School District —Tax Increase No

Measure H Union Elementary School District—Tax Increase No

SVARW AND PROPOSITION 14

Gloria Hom will be discussing the ballot propositions at our May 19th General Meeting. If you vote by mail before then, our board members want you to know of our opposition to Proposition 14, the open primaries measure. It could prove a disaster for Republican candidates. The two leading candidates for an office, regardless of party affiliations, would be in a run off vote in November. They could be of the same party.
