Candidate Forum —Local Non-Partisan Offices

One of the advantages to being a member of SVARW is having the opportunity to hear from candidates first hand and make your decisions on who to support. With so many races in the June 8th primary. SVARW is holding two candidate forums:

March 17 th – Candidates running for local nonpartisan offices have been invited. This includes candidates for Santa Clara County Sheriff, District Attorney, Supervisor and for San Jose City Council.

April 21st -- Republican candidates running for California State Legislature and for U.S. House of Representatives.

You may have read the January 25, 2010, article in the *San Jose Mercury News*, "Santa Clara County sheriff race heats up for first time in 12 years", that describes the battle shaping up to defeat incumbent Sheriff Laurie Smith. After winning election 12 years ago, Laurie Smith ran unopposed and easily won re-election in the past two elections, now she has three challengers. Join us on March 17th to hear from the candidates for sheriff. If no candidate receives a 51% majority in June, the top two finishers will battle it out in November.

Santa Clara County is governed by five county supervisors. Don Gage representing District 1, who was the only Republican among the five supervisors, is termed out. Los Gatos Mayor Mike Wasserman is the only Republican among a sea of candidates to replace Don Gage.

The City of San Jose is the only city in the county where candidates for city council seats run in the primary election. If the candidate receives 51% of the vote they are elected. If not, the top two vote getters face off in November. SJ City Council seats for Districts 1, 3, 5, 7 and 9 are up for election this year. Whether you live in San Jose or not, you life in Santa Clara County is effected by the decisions of the San Jose City Council. They lead and the rest of the cities in the county follow...whether it's banning plastic bags or decisions regarding the San Jose Airport.



SVARW Re-confirms Endorsement of Assemblyman Chuck DeVore for U.S. Senate

SVARW endorsed Chuck DeVore for U.S. Senate when his major competitor was Carly Fiorina. With the entry of a major candidate in the race for U.S. Senate, SVARW felt it was appropriate to re-examine the SVARW endorsement for U.S. Senate. Tom Campbell moved from candidacy for governor to running for U.S. Senate. SVARW reaffirmed it's endorsement of Chuck DeVore for U.S. Senate for the following reasons:

- Throughout his political career Tom Campbell has billed himself as a "social moderate" while Chuck DeVore is clearly a Republican on social issues. DeVore's voting record indicates his support of the family as the basic unit of society and support of family values and ethics.
- Chuck DeVore has been working and fundraising for his run for U.S. Senate for the last year. Campbell has just started.
- Tom Campbell claims to have been fiscally conservative while he was in Congress; however, most recently –in <u>opposition</u> to the Republican Party and Governor Schwarzenegger <u>– he supported increasing</u> taxes in California through propositions 1A and 1B. These were defeated dramatically by the voters.
- Both Chuck DeVore and Tom Campbell have shown that when if office, they are willing to talk with constituents.

We need to have a Republican running against Boxer who stands out against her, as Senatorelect Brown did in Massachusetts, and Chuck DeVore is this type of candidate. People are looking for a change and not just a Republican who often votes/acts like a Democrat.


