Donna is a retired teacher of 33 years and has served on various boards, including a two-year term on the Cupertino Planning Commission and various volunteer positions. She most recently was awarded the CREST award for volunteering by the city, and Citizen of the Year by the Chamber of Commerce. Of the six candidates running for two positions, Donna is the only Republican. Donna has also been endorsed by the Cupertino Chamber of Commerce.



Jim Davis, Sunnyvale City Council, Seat #6

Jim is widely respected and recognized in the Sunnyvale community, having served 25 years in law enforcement and as a fire fighter. Legislation

STATE LEGISLATION SB 48

SB 48- Building upon AB 537 and SB 777, (which have passed over the last six years), the Fair, Accurate, Inclusive and Respectful (FAIR) Education Act amended the Education Code to require that social science instruction include, at all grade levels, the contributions of lesbian, gay, bisexual and transgenderpersons. There is no requirement for prior notification of parents and no opt-out provision. The bill becomes effective in January 2012 (Bill analysis indicates that due to fiscal challenges, "the current framework development and instructional materials adoption activities have been suspended until the 2015-16 fiscal year. Thus it will be several years before new instructional materials for kindergarten and grades 1-8, inclusive, are adopted.") SB 48 adds "sexual orientation" and "gender" to a list of characteristics about which textbooks, instructional materials, and school activities may not "reflect adversely."

Thanks to all who educated people within their sphere of influence about this egregious bill and obtained signatures for its repeal.

The good news is that proponents indicate that the goal of more than 500,000 valid signatures has a good chance of being reached! Thank you for your help in gathering signatures to place the referendum on the ballot next year!





Support Our Military

Overseas Coupon Program

Send your coupons to soldiers overseas! This program serves military families by assisting us to forward "manufacturer's coupons" to overseas military bases. To date, we have sent \$13,397.68 in coupons to the U.S. Navy base in Gaeta, Italy.

These bundles of coupons are placed on tables, at the PX and Commissary, or handed out for use by military members and families on base. This helps a military family save valuable dollars and stretch their budget. Please follow these four easy steps:

- 1. Clip your "manufacturer's coupons" with expiration dates that are no more than one month past their expiration date.
- 2. Please sort your coupons into "food" and "non-food" bundles and place them into Ziploc baggies.
- 3. Tally the dollar total for each bundle and mark on each baggie with a felt tipped pen.
- 4. Bring them to the next SVARW meeting and give them to Christina Sand.

Christina will add up all the tallies and send the coupons overseas.

Remember: the magic words are "manufacturer's coupon". Do not send restaurant coupons, assistance vouchers, food stamps, or any other assistance items, which generally have a personal name on them or are issued for a specific person to use. Do not send store coupons, which are only good at the store named, and cannot be used on a military base overseas.
