





His high profile advocacy has attracted scores of media attention and inspired an ongoing outpouring of volunteers and donations in the cause to find Sierra. Mr. Klaas' journey as a nationally prominent advocate began in 1993 with his own family's tragic experience of the kidnap and murder of his 12-year old daughter Polly.

A tireless and effective advocate for preventing crimes against children, Mr. Klaas has appeared on many television programs and syndicated talk shows, and is a regular resource for CNN, FOX and MSNBC. He has written for *Newsweek* Magazine and newspapers such as the *SF Chronicle*, *SJ Mercury News* and the *Cleveland Plain Dealer*. Mr. Klaas has shared a podium with leaders including President Bill Clinton, Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger and Mayor Rudy Giuliani.



The Federal Election Commission (FEC) allows an individual to contribute up to \$2,500 per election; a qualified political action committee may contribute up \$5,000 per election. The primary and general elections are considered separate elections for the purposes of these limits. Federal Law requires us to report the name, mailing address, occupation, and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in an election cycle. Contributions from foreign nationals are prohibited. No corporate checks or corporate credit cards may be accepted. Partnership and LLC contributions may be accepted under certain guidelines.

Contributions are not considered charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes.
