
SB 29

Extends “emergency” measure of sending VBM ballot to all registrants through January, 2022

AB 37

Makes “emergency” measure of sending VBM ballot to all registrants permanent

AB 53

**Makes Election Day a holiday by replacing
Presidents Day in even years**

SB 90

Requires ballot label to contain names of all major proponents and opponents

SB 35

Extends the “No Electioneering Zone”
from 100 to 200 feet

AB 53

For initiatives and referenda, the ballot shall read: “Shall the statute (or ordinance) (stating the nature thereof, including any identifying number or title) be **REJECTED OR ADOPTED?**” Opposite the statement of the statute or ordinance to be voted on and to its right, or immediately below if there is not sufficient space opposite the statement or ordinance and to its right, the words **“YES” AND “NO”** shall be printed on separate lines, with voting targets.

AB 53

If a voter marks the voting target next to the printed word “Yes,” the voter’s vote shall be counted in favor of the *referendum and against* adoption of the ordinance or statute.

If the voter marks the voting target next to the printed word “No,” the voter’s vote shall be counted *against the referendum and in favor of adoption of the ordinance or statute*.
